

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS

Each author can submit no more than 3 abstracts on the CARO-2020 topic. The organizing committee of the congress reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not meet the requirements below. The deadline for submitting abstracts is September 30, 2020.

Registration

- 1) Volume no more than 2500 characters without spaces (approximately 450-500 words). The title of the thesis, authors and the name of the institution are not included in the total number of characters. The text of the abstracts should be provided in Russian or English.
- 2) The topic (title) of the thesis should not include abbreviations.
- 3) The names of the authors are given after the title of the report. In the list of authors, the last name is first indicated, then the full name and patronymic of each author.
- 4) The name of the organization is indicated in accordance with official documents. If there are several authors, they work in different organizations, then a superscript (1, 2, etc.) is placed after the initials, corresponding to the organization indicated below under the same number. If the author is one or all authors work in the same organization, then the indexes are not put. The institution in which the first author of the work works is indicated first. Writing format: full name of the institution, city, country.
- 5) Email addresses of authors are indicated in the order similar to the logic of specifying the names of institutions.

Registration of bibliography

The rules for the preparation of lists of references for authors are drawn up taking into account the "Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals" of the International Committee of Editors of Medical Journals.

A correct description of the sources used in the bibliography is a guarantee that the cited publication will be taken into account when evaluating the scientific activities of its authors and organizations where they work. The bibliographic description of domestic journals is complete, foreign ones must correspond to the style of PubMed or MEDLINE. The order of compiling the list: Author (s) of a book or article (with a group of authors up to 6 people inclusive, all are mentioned, with large groups of authors - 6 first authors "and others", in foreign - "et al."); If the authors of the books are editors, after the surname should be put "ed.", In foreign "ed."; Title of the book and article; Output.
